

Consonant: qu /kw/ queen

- Two letters with two sounds /kw/ but receive only one tap. Technically, this is not a consonant digraph because it produces two distinct sounds /kw/, but we treat it as a consonant digraph for tapping purposes.
- The letter **q** is always followed by **u**, and the **u** does not make a vowel sound and has no independent value. For example, the word **quack** has five letters, three separate sounds, and receives three taps: one tap for **qu** /kw/ with two fingers glued together, one tap for /ă/, and one tap for **ck** /k/ with two fingers glued together.
